**TRAIL NOTES:** Hills, fields, dirt and rocky trail, gravel road, river crossings, may encounter cattle or wildlife.

There will be NO SMOKING allowed on the trail and littering will not be tolerated.

There may be a few gates to open/close behind you depending on number of volunteers available.

Hoof protection is recommended but is at rider discretion. NO leg protection is permitted as per TRAC rules.

**CAMP NOTES:** We have *back-country* style field camping (NO HOOK UPS etc.) There are no penned areas for horses available so you must bring panels, electric fence or keep horse(s) tied to trailer.

We advise leaving dogs at home but IF you bring dogs they must be on leash/tied at *your camp at all times and* cannot be a nuisance/barking etc. Failure to abide by this rule will result in disqualification!



## DIRECTIONS to the:

### From Edmonton area:

Head south on the QE2 (Highway 2)

At the Olds Turn off turn West onto Highway 27 and go 25 km to Highway 22

Turn left (South) on highway 22

#### From Highway 22:

Turn west on secondary highway #579 and watch for the sign for Rivers Edge Camp.

Go 5 km and turn North (right) on Range Road 50

Go 3 km and turn West (left) onto Township Road 295A

Go 1 km and turn at your first right.

### From Calgary area:

Head North on the QE2 (Highway 2)

Go West on #567 (Yankee Valley Blvd just at south end of Airdrie)

Go 32 km to Highway 22 and turn right

#### From Highway 22:

Turn west on secondary highway #579 and watch for the sign for Rivers Edge Camp.

Go 5 km and turn north (right) on Range Road 50

Go 3 km and turn west (left) onto Township Road 295A

Go 1 km and turn at your first right.
