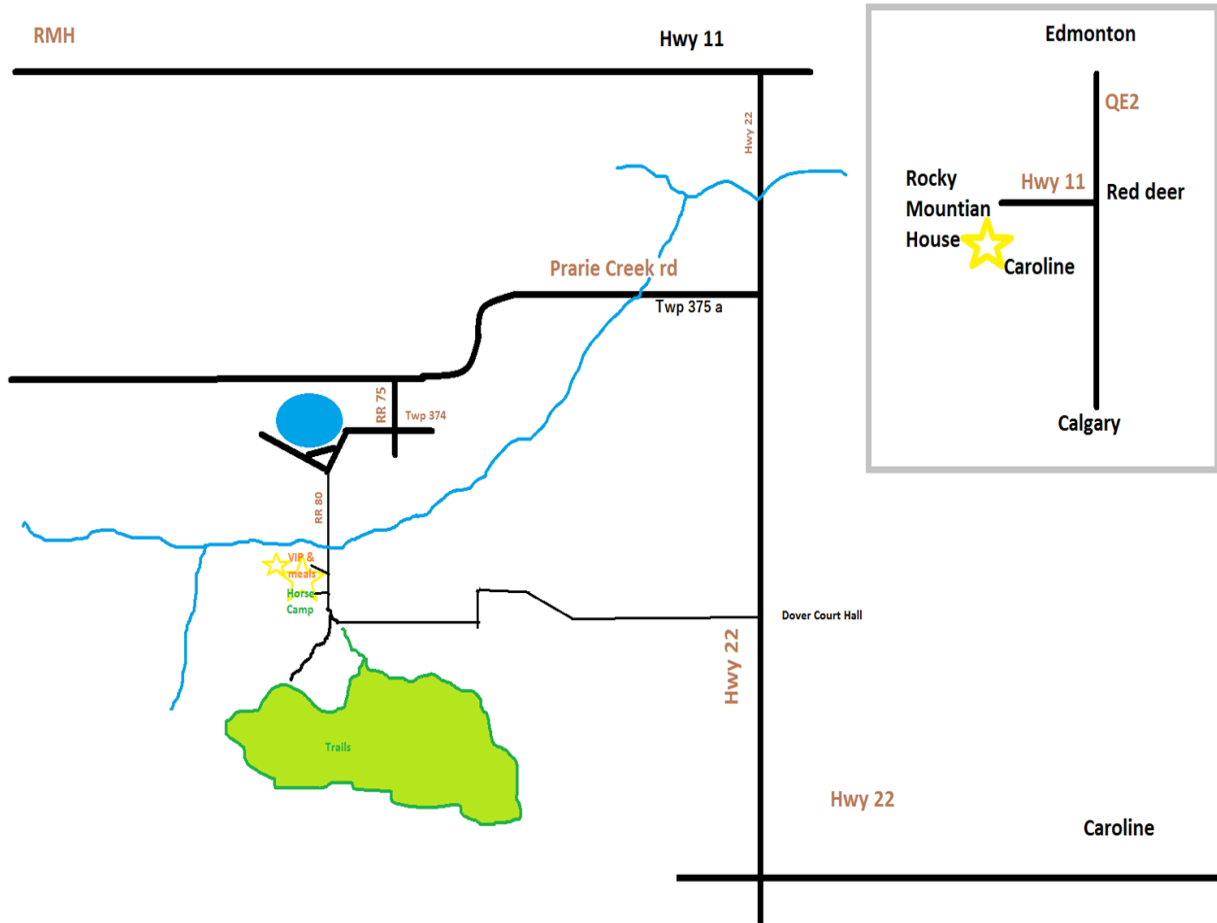

Trail: Sand, river rock, grass and pasture lands with minimal road riding. There will be several shallow water crossings and you can expect to encounter cattle in the grazing leases. There will be no smoking permitted on trail and littering will not be tolerated. There will be a few gates to open and close behind you. For your horse's hoof protection, shoes and boots are to be used at the riders discretion but no leg protection is permitted. This trail **has** been successfully ridden by multiple barefoot horses however does include gravel and smooth river rock.

Camp Notes: ***We strongly encourage you to leave your dog at home.** If you must bring them, dogs must be kept on a leash and in your camp at all times. Failure to abide by this rule will result in disqualification. If you plan to arrive in camp before Friday please notify Jayme Benoit so we can use your help to set up! jaymebenoit@live.ca or text 403-895-5353

Directions: From Red Deer – Travel West on Hwy 11 then turn south on Hwy 22 towards Caroline. Turn West on Prairie Creek Rd (Twp 375A). Just after the hill and curve, turn South on RR 75 (Struble lake sign). Follow RR 75 South until Twp 374 (Struble lake sign again) and head West. Follow the curve in the road to the South away from the lake. Turn West after the bridge.
