Trail: Dirt and grass trails with limited gravel and asphalt, horses do not need to be shod.

ALL RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A HELMET – IF YOU DO NOT BRING A HELMET YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO RIDE.

No dogs allowed.

Directions:

Wild Timber Ranch is located at on the doorsteps of the foothills near beautiful Bergen, Alberta.

Please see the attached map for directions.

- Legal Land description is 17-31-5W5
- Latitude/Longitude Location is 51.6570, -114.6750

From Red Deer and points North:

- South on QE2 to Olds Turnoff (Hwy 27)
- West on 27 to Hwy 22
- South on 22 to Bergen Road
- West on Bergen Road about 9 km (past Bergen Store and over Bridge) to RR 5.3 (Fallen Timber Trail)
- South on RR 5.3 to Twp. Rd 31.2 Turn West (you will go through two large 90 degree curves in the road, the first road after the curves is the 31.2)
- West on 31.2 for 2 km (you will pass RR 5.4), and turn north into our drive

From Calgary and Points South:

- Go to Hwy 22 (west of Calgary)
- Go 5.3 km north of the town of Cremona to the Burnt Timber Road
- West on Burnt Timber about 9.7 km to the Fallen Timber Trail (also known as RR 5.3)
- Go north on Fallen Timber 3.3 km, veer left (west) at Y, cross bridge, then immediately turn North on Fallen Timber Road / RR 5.3
- North on Fallen Timber Trail (RR 5.3) 3 km to Twp Rd. 31.2
- West on 31.2 for 2 km (you will pass RR 5.4) and turn north into our drive
